May I be one of the first to congratulate you on your successful campaign to be elected as my local representative in Westminster. I particularly look forward to seeing you represent my interests as a motorcyclist in the coming parliamentary term.

I would like to draw your attention to the Motorcycle Action Group (MAG), a long-standing and effective lobbying organisation that looks after the interests of our motorcycling community. It is well-placed to provide any specific expert advice in respect to motorcycling. MAG can be contacted at central-office@mag-uk.org and is always happy to assist with advice, information and opinion on motorcycling matters.

Personally, I would initially like to ask you to support my interests by ensuring we get swift and positive completion to work begun in the last parliament. These workstreams were as follows:

1. Consultation on ending sales of new non-zero tailpipe emission L-category vehicles. This covers a consultation begun two years ago on plans to end the sale of internal combustion engine motorcycles. I strongly oppose the proposals and would ask that you do all you can to ensure that these proposals are dropped.
2. Consultation on motorcycles in bus lanes. This consultation (originally scheduled to close on 9th June) was extended to 16th July. I would urge you to support Option 2: Allow motorcycles to access bus lanes by default.
3. Licence review. An announcement was to be made that a full review of the motorcycle licensing regime would be launched this summer. The announcement was pre-empted by the early general election. Please will you push for this essential review to be formally signed off and launched as soon as possible.

I am happy to discuss any of these issues if you need more detail, or you can get expert advice from the Motorcycle Action Group's main office.

Once again, congratulations on your successful campaign and I look forward to further communication over the coming years.
