## Motorcycle Action Group National Police Force Bike Theft Rankings

This is the third annual publication of the Motorcycle Action Group's National Police Force Bike Theft Rankings. This publication covers data for reported thefts of motorcycles in 2020.

The data is obtained via Freedom of Information requests lodged with all 45 territorial police forces in the UK. We continue to be unable to secure data from all contacted Police Forces.

With the world-wide Covid pandemic and lockdown measures taking place throughout all four nations of the UK, 2020 was a far from normal year with respect to crime. As with many other crimes the total number of motorcycle thefts nationally showed a significant decrease. The average theft rate fell from 19 per 1000 registered motorcycles in 2019 to 13 per 1000 registered in 2020. The national average is calculated on Police National Computer data, not reported thefts totalled from the FOI responses.

London remains by far the worst affected area with 8138 thefts. A surprise result places Gwent as the second worst ranked police force in the UK. The 2020 theft rate for London was 69 per 1000, but for Gwent the rate has more than doubled from 14 per 1000 in 2019 to 35 per 1000 in 2020.


It should be noted that for a second year Greater Manchester Police have failed to provide data. We have received data for Wiltshire and South Wales for the first time this year, but the significant holes in the data from Manchester, Scotland, Hampshire and Thames Valley are disappointing.

#### UK RANKING BY POLICE FORCE

City of London and Metropolitan Police are combined due to the small geographical area covered by City of London.

Ranking is by number of motorcycles reported stolen divided by number of motorcycles registered in the force area. This is to provide a fair ranking system for forces with varying geographical and population jurisdictional size.

#### ACCURACY OF REPORTING

The process of collating these data for 2020 has continued to reinforce the view that confidence in the accuracy of reported motorcycle theft data is low.

We caution against placing great store in data changes whether laterally from force to force or longitudinally from year to year within a force area.

Questioning of data for Hertfordshire led to claims by the force that the initial data supplied was in error. This data was then replaced after a lengthy process of reapplying for a separate Freedom of Information request with figures that were demonstrably inconsistent with previous years' data. We have provided data in this report from the initial response which appears more credible in the context of previous responses but fails to answer claims made by the force that motorcycle theft had reduced during 2020 in line with the national average. Both sets of data demonstrated a year on year increase from 2019 to 2020.

In a similar vein the data supplied by Gwent appears to be suspect due to the notable increased theft rate reported which appears beyond statistical probability compared to the average national picture. We will be investigating Gwent's data further subject to co-operation by that force.
