

### Motorcycle Action Group National Police Force Bike Theft Rankings

Motorcycles are, on average, **seven times more likely to be stolen** than any other vehicle type in the UK.

As with most issues of this kind the picture varies from region to region, but until now there has been a lack of detailed evidence.

The Motorcycle Action Group (MAG) has undertaken this project in an attempt to start to lay the foundations for a more in-depth understanding of the issue of bike theft across the country and hopefully to introduce a greater awareness amongst riders and police forces of the local impacts.

It is hoped that this process will help to create a degree of competitiveness between forces to show improvement and also to highlight where tactics are achieving results so that best practice can be investigated and shared.

Data has been sourced via Freedom of Information (FOI) requests with, it has to be said, some patchy results. Of the 45 police forces, 5 were unable to give the most basic level of data due to reporting methods that fail to record vehicle type in a retrievable format.


This updated edition now contains figures for Humberside, Leicestershire and Thames Valley Police, plus corrected figures for Derbyshire Police. Derbyshire initially supplied incorrect data due to an administrative error. Note that the Thames Valley data supplied covered the entire period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018. We have quoted the average annual figure across the two years.

#### UK RANKING BY POLICE FORCE

City of London and Metropolitan Police are combined due to the small geographical area covered by City of London.

Ranking is by number of motorcycles reported stolen divided by number of motorcycles registered in the force area. This is to provide a fair ranking system for forces with varying geographical and population jurisdictional size.

Essex did provide a figure, but stated that they were "unable to differentiate between whether the vehicle was involved in the crime (i.e. used by the suspect), or whether it was part of the crime (e.g. stolen)."

#### ACCURACY OF CRIME REPORTING

It has been brought to our attention that there is variability in performance between police forces when it comes to recording of crime. The quoted numbers in Freedom of Information responses may actually be lower than the real numbers.

We have produced the below adjusted rankings based on the most recent Crime Data Integrity Inspections by Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary and Fire & Rescue Services (HMICFRS). The reports present overall crime-recording rates for each force, but it should be noted that the most recent reports date from anywhere between 2014 and 2019. The adjustments may therefore introduce some bias for which we cannot be held responsible.
